## **Reset/Restart Plan 2020-2021**

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Faircrest Memorial Middle School



Due to a statewide mandate issued by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and the Ohio Department of Health, all students grades K-12 are required to wear facial coverings (masks) at all times when on school grounds and when being transported using school transportation.

## First Week of School for Students

### **Aug. 18 - 5th Grade Only**

Distribute current schedules during HR

Building tour for students by their homeroom teacher due to not having Ready Fest

Class Meeting - To welcome and review health/safety plans

### **Aug. 19 - All Students**

Distribute current schedules during HR - Review where rooms and teachers are located due to not having a Ready Fest.

Class Meetings for 6th, 7th, and 8th during their Double Dose time

Normal Schedule

### **Aug. 21**

Yearbooks will be passed out right before dismissal. Students will not be permitted to sign each other's yearbook.



# Social Distancing

## Breakfast

Students entering off the bus will get breakfast when entering the building and move directly to homerooms.

Parent drop off students will get breakfast upon entering the building and may eat in the cafeteria.

## Lunch

We will be moving to a paperless payment system for lunches, additional information will be coming soon

Prepackaged lunches will be available for students.

Student seating will be arranged to maximize space.

## Cafeteria During Lunch

Seating will be appropriately distanced. Labels will be placed on lunch tables where students will sit. Students will be dismissed from their tables to go through lunch line by the supervising staff members.

At the end of lunch students will leave in a staggered manner after being dismissed by staff.

Directional markings will be used to support safe students movement.



## Classroom

Classrooms seating will be rearranged and non essential furniture will be removed to accommodate social distancing to the best of our ability.

Digital textbooks will be used to eliminate sharing.

We will do our best to minimize the sharing of equipment. However any equipment that must be shared will be sanitized between each use (for example - Science equipment and Physical Education equipment)



## Student Movement:

Classroom dismissal will be staggered at times to reduce the number of students in the hallway.

Direction markings will be placed on the floors and stairwells and traffic patterns will be changed in the hallways.

Restrooms: Signs will be posted on doors and we will monitor to the best of our ability during transition time so maximum capacity is not exceeded.

Staff: Teachers will be at their doorways during changes.



## Arrival

Buses will stagger sending students into the building.

Staff will be at doorways or in the hallways to manage distancing.

Parent drop off - Students will enter the building, get breakfast from a grab and go cart, and move to the cafeteria to sit at tables.

This plan may need adjusted once approximate daily numbers for parent drop off are determined. Students may be sent to homerooms a few minutes early.

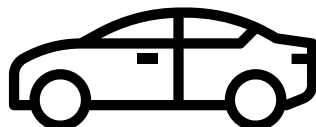
## Dismissal



Will be started approximately 5 mins early and use a staggered dismissal when sending students to their bus and parent pick-up.

Parent pick-up students will report to an area where they can social distance from other students. They will then be sent out to parents as they pull up to the building.

Staff members will be used to monitor and coordinate dismissal time.





## Classroom Cleaning

Staff and students will wipe down their areas before moving to their next class with safety instructions from the teacher/monitor.



## Self Sanitizing Stations

Multiple stations have been provided strategically throughout the building.



## PPE

Students and Staff are required to follow district guidelines regarding facial coverings  
Facial coverings must be worn while in the building or participating in school activities.  
Facial Covering breaks may occur throughout the day by permission of a school staff member at approved times and locations  
Facial coverings must meet all dress code requirements



## Cleaning and Sanitizing Awareness

Posters for display and signage will be provided throughout the building for awareness and proper health procedures  
Appropriate training will occur for all students for handwashing, social distancing, and use of face coverings



## Restrooms

Students are to clean and sanitize hands before exiting the restroom.  
Restrooms will be cleaned and sanitized throughout the school day.



## Safety Drills

Staggered dismissal for evacuation.  
Safety/Security drills will be conducted as a conversation with students when possible.



## Student Health

Students & Parents are required to do a daily health check before arrival at school.  
Students complaining of health concerns will be sent to the office or escorted to be evaluated by the nurse to determine course of action.  
Staff may use thermometers to check student temperatures.  
Students with daily medication needs will report to the clinic as scheduled throughout the day  
Students who show COVID symptoms will report to the office and may then be moved to an isolated room monitored by a staff member .  
If students are found to be COVID positive Canton Local schools will follow The Stark County Health Department protocols for return to school



## Social Emotional Well Being - Students and Staff:

School counselors are available for in person and Virtual Academy students  
Commquest Counselors are available for ALL students



## Visitors

Visitors are not permitted with the exception of delivery services, local agencies, and service providers. Visitors will be required to wear proper face covering upon entering the school building.

Those individuals picking up or dropping off their child will be permitted to enter the waiting area, with a proper face covering.



## Field Trips

No field trips will take place until further notice



## Learning Gaps:

No field trips will take place until further notice MAP data will be collected and used to gauge student levels.
