



Career Technical Education (CTE) Programs



CTE programs are designed to give students hands-on experience to prepare them for the workforce or for a college-level program in the career pathway. Many programs offer the opportunity for college credit to be earned through Ohio's College Credit Plus (CCP) Program or articulation agreement.

South Stark Career Academy, which offers Career Tech to students from Canton South, Perry, East Canton, and Sandy Valley, offers the following programs:

Culinary Arts	Perry	6 (3 per year)	At Perry periods 1-5. Science is pushed to senior year unless student chooses to take it online or ride the 6:50am bus to Perry to fit into junior schedule
Health Occupations	Perry	6 (3 per year)	Must be able to get yourself to CS by 6:50am-At Perry periods 1-5 - Requires Anatomy
Medical Tech Prep	Perry	6 (2 jr/4 Sr year)	At Perry periods 1-7 -Requires Anatomy and Chemistry to be taken
Teacher Academy	Perry	6 (3 per year)	At Perry program only -Students will need to take the Accuplacer for this program
Video Production	Perry	4 (2 per year)	At Perry periods 1-5. Some projects will require after school attendance at various events.
Horticulture	Sandy Valley	4 (2 per year)	At Sandy Valley periods 1-5A

CTE Recruiting Process

Selecting a CTE program is a big decision for our students. Students are committing to a lot of time and energy focused in one general area. Based on classes required to graduate and the amount of time that is required for the CTE program, there may not be enough time for students to take other elective courses. Please talk with your parent/guardian or counselors about what you are learning during this CTE recruiting process or if you have questions. To help our students make an educated decision about applying for a CTE program, we offer many opportunities to learn about CTE programs during the recruiting process. The schedule for this year is below:

Event	Date	Description
CTE Showcase (Parents are invited to attend this event)	November 15	All programs will be set up in the Aux Gym. Students will come down during their U. S. History classes. They will have the opportunity to go visit all of the programs we offer to learn more about the programs and what they will learn in each program. Before students leave, they will given the opportunity to complete a Google Form. On this for they will be able to select up to 2 programs they would like to visit at Perry and 2 programs they would like to visit at Canton South to learn more about each program and see the labs associated with the programs. Students do not have to visit any programs if they are not interested.
Field Trip Permission Slips Due (to visit programs)	November 30	Students who would like to visit a program that is housed at Perry or Sandy Valley will have a permission slip sent to them that must be signed by a parent/guardian and student's teachers for the periods marked. This must be turned in by the end of the school day on this date or the student will not be permitted to attend the field trip.
Visit Sandy Valley Program	December 4	Students who expressed interest in visiting the Horticulture program housed at Sandy Valley and turned in their permission form by November 30th will go down to Sandy Valley from - to visit the program
Visit Perry Programs	December 5	Students who expressed interest in visiting a CTE program housed at Perry and turned in their permission forms by November 30th will go over to Perry from 9-10am to visit their selected programs.
Visit Canton South Programs	December 5	Students who expressed interest in visiting a CTE program housed at Canton South will be receiving passes to go to those program from 1-2pm.
CTE Applications Due (NOTE: This is a strict deadline.)	December 21	Once students have decided they would like to be in a CTE program, they must fill out the online CTE application by the end of the day. Students that submit their application late will not be given first consideration for acceptance into a program. Students will have the option to select a 2nd program to apply for in case they are not accepted into their first choice program and placed on a wait list.
Acceptance Letters Delivered	January 31	If students are accepted into a program, they will be given an acceptance letter with their scheduling materials at the 10th grade scheduling assembly.
