# PROGRAMS ARE COMPETITIVE



There are a limited number of seats available in each program. Seats are split between all 4 districts in the South Stark Career Academy.

For example, if Animal Science has 21 seats, each school is able to assign a set number of students to those seats.

Students are awarded points based on their GPA and attendance rate from 9th grade and the 1st semester of 10th grade.





# RECRUITING PROCESS



## Showcase Activity

- On Thursday, November 15th, sophomores will attend a Showcase in the Aux Gym where all programs will have tables setup so that you can ask the teachers and students questions about the programs.
- There will be computers setup where you will tell us if you would like to visit the Horticulture program at Sandy Valley, 1-2 programs at Perry, and 1-2 programs at Canton South during class to see the lab and what is done in that program.



# RECRUITING PROCESS



## Program Visits

On December 4th, we will visit Sandy Valley's Horticulture program.

On December 5th, we will visit Perry programs that you signed up for in the morning and Canton South programs in the afternoon.

To visit a Perry/Sandy program, you will be sent a permission slip that must be returned to the Student Services Office by 2:40pm on November 30th.

**Late permission slips cannot be accepted-No exceptions!**



# RECRUITING PROCESS



## CTE Application

**This is the most important part of the process.** You will be sent a Google Form called the “CTE Application” on December 5th where you can apply for a 1st and 2nd choice program. If you want to be considered for acceptance into a CTE program, you must have this application completed **by December 21st - the last day before Winter Break.**

Any applications received after this date will still be considered, but students will receive 0 points regardless of their GPA and attendance records.

# RECRUITING PROCESS

## Acceptance Letters



You will receive a letter before scheduling for the 19-20 school year telling you if you have been accepted into a program that you applied for.

If a student does not get into their 1st choice program, they will be placed on a waitlist for that program and then considered for their 2nd choice program. If a student is placed on the waitlist for both 1st and 2nd choice programs, they will NOT receive a letter. Feel free to email me if you do not receive a letter to check your placement status.



# CTE CONSIDERATIONS



- CTE Programs are 2-3 periods both junior and senior year.
- Students who are credit deficient are often not able to be placed into CTE programs.
- Students sometimes have to make tough choices such as choosing between their CTE program and different elective classes that they would also like to take.
- Talk with your counselor if you have any questions about this.
